Language and **Training Services**

(A) Program Information

1. LINC Program

We have been funded by Citizenship and Immigration of Canada (CIC) since 1992 to run adult language training classes to assist new immigrants in their settlement and social integration. English language skills are the basic tool enabling newcomers to participate in Canadian society which in turn facilitates their social, cultural, economic and political integration. The objective of the LINC program is to enhance the newcomers' English language proficiency to help them handle everyday situations, understand their new country better, find work and ultimately participate in society as active citizens.

Our English language classes range from the literacy level to Levels 6/7 catering to the varying needs of newcomers from different age groups and backgrounds. Since settlement is not achieved by learning the language alone, our LINC teachers and staff seek to connect newcomers to different sources in order to promote their social awareness and community involvement. Lessons are delivered not merely in the classroom but also through active participation in field trips, visits and class presentations. Our unit provides integrated settlement support by closely collaborating with the agency's settlement team and connecting clients to settlement counselling, Job Search Workshops, the Host program and a whole range of community service programming.

Currently we have 43 classes operating on a 7-day schedule out of 3 locations in Scarborough: Sheppard/Kennedy, Sheppard/Midland and Finch/McCowan. The availability of computer laboratories, the provision of childminding service and transportation assistance for eligible clients all work to provide the support newcomers may need to access the LINC program.

2. ESL Classes

Classes taking place in accessible community locations are offered in cooperation with TCDSB and are open to newcomers, long time residents and citizens alike. Apart from English language training, Citizenship Preparatory classes are also offered to ESL clients.

3. Focused Training classes

In 2010 our unit will put forward a variety of skills building courses for both children and adults. Through these focused training classes we hope to enhance children's cognitive and social skills. For adults, the training focuses on strengthening the participants' soft skills as well as their ability to communicate in both social and work situations.

(B) Highlights in 2009

(C) LINC Childminding Program

Childminding services are provided to most classes scheduled at all of the 3 LINC sites. We offer structured programming and a cozy learning environment for the children to develop their social, cognitive and language skills to assist in their well rounded development. Our array of educational and recreational activities helps prepare students for entry into kindergarten.

(D) LINK Student Club

The LINK Student Club was formed in January 2009 with the objective of meeting our students' expressed need for social networks and skills building. Through activities such as English conversation circles, public speaking training, workplace communication groups, interest classes and reunion parties etc., our LINC students have the opportunity to get together for fun and camaraderie, share information on settlement issues, and to use their talents and expertise in helping one another through volunteering in the operation of the club and the facilitation of interest groups.

The idea of the student club has been well received by

our LINC students and registration for membership has been overwhelming. In 2009, over 800 LINC students have registered to become members of the club. A total of 19 programs were organized with 745


